

Frequently Asked Questions

Where and when do you meet?

We meet every Sunday at 10am in our own purpose-built facility in Kelson, Lower Hutt. We also have life groups that meet during the week across the Hutt Valley.

How long does the service go for?

Our services are typically about 75 minutes. We offer hot drinks and light refreshments in our café after the service and would love to catch up with you then. If you are pressed for time or need to leave early, please feel to use one of our Connection Cards to leave us your details as we would love to catch up with you at another time.

Do you have car parking available?

Yes, we have a large on-site carpark including disability spaces. There is also plenty of road parking available.

What do I need to do?

You are our guest. Please relax and enjoy your time with us. Our services start off with a time of combined praise and worship followed by relevant teaching. Our prayer is that you will be encouraged in your journey of discovering God as you spend time with us in God's house. Once a month as a church we share in communion together as a way of remembering the sacrifice that Jesus Christ made and His gift of salvation that he offers for to all mankind.

What about my children?

During the service, we offer the following programmes:

Power Sparks: for 2-6yr old children

Power Zone: for 6yr to Yr6 children

Voltage: For Yr7-Yr11 preteens and teenagers

During term time, Oxygen Youth meet weekly on a Friday evening from 7-9pm, and provide a full programme for intermediate and high school students.
