

Frequently Asked Questions

1. **Where and when do you meet?**

We meet every Sunday at 10am in our own purpose-built facility in Kelson, Lower Hutt. We also have Life Groups that meet during the week across the Hutt Valley.

2. **How long does the service go for?**

Our services are typically about 75 minutes. We offer tea and coffee in our café after the meeting, and would love to meet you then. If you are pressed for time or need to leave early however, please feel free to leave your details as we would be very happy to catch up with you at another time.

3. **Do you have car parking available?**

Yes, we have a large on-site carpark including disability spaces. There is also plenty of road parking available.

4. **What do you do?**

You are our guest. Please relax and enjoy your time with us. We endeavour to present our services in a creative and fresh way that will encourage you in your journey of discovering God. Our services have contemporary music with a live band, followed by relevant teaching. Once a month we celebrate communion as a way to remember the sacrifice of Jesus Christ.

5. **What about my children?**

During the Sunday service, we offer the following programmes:

Power Tots – for babies and toddlers (our Parent's Room provides for video of the service as it runs). You are welcome to either remain with your child, or leave them with one of our friendly and experienced helpers.

Power Sparks – for 3 – 5 years old

Power Zone – for 6 - 11 years old

During the week, Oxygen Youth meet on a Friday evening from 7 – 9pm, and provide a full programme for intermediate and high school students.

6. **Do I need to bring a Bible?**

All you need is you. We believe in the Bible and our pastors use it as their main reference point for teaching. If you have a Bible and would like to bring it, please feel free, but it is certainly not mandatory and the verses will be displayed on screen for you to read.
